Continued approach to 35 north of Jeju. No further approach approved because of Jeju traffic.

Spiral from 800' to 8000' over IPDAS

Returned to Osan at 7000'

Landed Osan at 1415

Wind condition 270 at 25knot

Light turbulence at 3000'
