Hold over Pan-gyo 5min for Spiral climb. Spiral climb over Pan-gyo from 500' to 3,000'

2nd spiral over R17 from 500' to 8,000'

Hold over Pyung-taek due to Osan airbase NOTAM.

Landed at 1247

June 5th afternoon flight.

Departed at 1410

Maintained 500'-1,000' all the way. Visibility 6SM with haze. Wind 160 at 3kts

Maintained 500' over Seo-an area for separation with NASA DC8

Spiral climb over R17 from 500' to 10,000'

Landed at 1726
